What colours can you see?

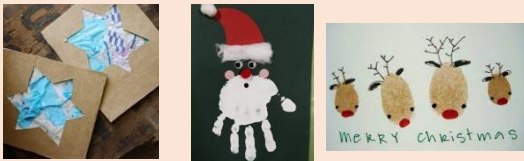
Can you make a repeated pattern?

Option 3: Christmas List

Some children might use their lines and circle shapes, some might use letters from their name and some children might use their robot talk to break up the sound before writing them.



Key vocabulary:

celebrate, collage, pattern, list, weigh, measure, mix, cut, bake, build, hide, roll, travel

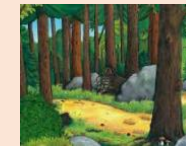


Option 5: Gruffalo's Cave
